## Call to Order:

A meeting of the Sebastian Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the Media Center on August 29, 2022, Mrs. Sherrill-Long called the meeting to order at 5:04 p.m. Stacey Cephus will record minutes for this meeting.

## Minutes:

SAC Committee reviewed March (the last meeting) SAC meeting minutes but did not approve minutes due to low attendance of parents.

## **New Business:**

School Grade- The school moved up from a low D to a very high B. A lot of the students moved one to two grade levels.

- Due to the new state testing, the school grade is only going to be judged on the students receiving score of three or higher on the test.
- This year the concentration will be on keeping students at least at a level three. The school will continue to support students that need the extra help.

New State Testing- The FAST is a new state test to replace the FSA. Kindergarten through fifth grade have already taken the first of the four tests for the school year. There will be three FAST tests (PM1, PM2, PM3); PM3 will count towards the school grade.

SIP Plan- The committee went over the schools new School Improvement Plan. The SIP Plan is broken up into quarter goals, in three categories Behavior, Academics, and Parent involvement.

- Behavior: One goal is to bring down the bus referrals by 25%. There has only been one so far. There was talk about rewards for students and training for the bus drivers. Mr. Adkins will be doing a non-Bullying course with all the classes.
- Academic: In order to stay at the school grade of a B we need 60% or more of our students to be a level three. Monitoring and planning together are going to be huge factors in achieving this goal.
- Parent involvement: There is a goal for the PTA to get 100 members in the first nine weeks. There are already 53 parent/guardian members, and 13 staff members, giving us a total of 66 members. There is a reward for the class and the teacher with the most parent members.

The SIP was voted on and was approved.
