Grant

Coordinator. He requested \$4,740.00 to purchase 1,400 ALBERT IO licenses. ALBERT is an online assessment suite that is used to prepare for unit tests in all subjects, AP Exams, SAT and ACT tests. The AP Department will pay the remaining \$5,000.00 for this program. Edie Collis motioned to approve this grant proposal and Carrie Nino seconded. Five were in favor and two were opposed; the

motion carried and the grant proposal was approved. \$4,740.00 shall be paid to renew ALBERT from the SAC Budget.

Principal's Report
