Stacey Miller called the meeting to order at 8:09 A.M on TEAMS and in Room 204 at Dodgertown.

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III Principal's Report:

- Mrs. Miller spoke about the SAC budget and gave the beginning balance for the 2021-2022 school year and the accounts that they funds come from.
- Mrs. Miller Ms. Vernet spoke about the SAC budget and gave the beginning balance for the 2022-2023 school year. Ms. Vernet spoke about closing the achievement gaps and discipline gaps with all students. Ms. Vernet shared the School Improvement Plan (SIP) and discussed the areas of focus and asked for input for shared the goals of our SIP.
