Budget Update: Funds at \$ 7,322.90

Funding Request:

- Mrs. Hastings presented a SAC funding request for a total of \$1,194.00 to purchase student awards in the form of plaques, medals, and trophies. from Dave's Sporting Good for the end of the year band banquet. This purchase is aligned to goal #1 creating and fostering a positive learning environment. The floor was opened for question and discussion. No questions or discussion occurred. B.
