## Approval of Minutes

## 2022-2023 SAC Budget was shared

Balance is \$1,987.32

- SAC Fund request was made to spend \$544 to obtain Printer Ink, advertised as 2 cartridges of each color for pre-existing printer with expiration potential based on current use to be 2 years.

## Discussion Items/Notes:

In regard to Funds request it was noted that the printer currently exists but lacks ink. It was also discussed that it would be more cost effective to only purchase the ink as opposed to an entire new color printer designated as a "Family Engagement" printer. Color copies are inclusive of but not isolated to Family Engagement so that was not a reasonable option.

Coach Dustin verbalized financial support from his department of \$250 to help obtain the ink if necessary. It was explained why those funds from PE could not be used for categorical reasons.
