Principal's Report:

Ms. Vernette spoke about the Final IMPACT Review Data and discussed monitoring and student engagement as our focus areas in Grades K-5. Ms. Vernette spoke about how instructional coaches delivered professional development on monitoring and student engagement to support our teachers to make an impact on student performance. Having these instructional practices used in the classroom daily will increase student's academic and behavioral performance and increase proficiency and close student gaps in learning. Intentional Review for STAR/FAST Assessment for K-5 students is happening for the next 5-8 weeks at our school. Teachers and instructional coaches will collaborate and use data to form small groups to support students in grades 3-5 with ELA and Math standards and K-2 with reading phonics skills, knowledge, and math standards. We will focus on all students and provide intentional differentiation in and out of the classroom to reduce student retention and increase enrichment opportunities.
