    - Orientation for 24-25 Calendar

        - Middle School PM Set time, open forum, walk schedules, it worked
        - Elementary seems to work ok
      - Check on graduation times, as district may switch to evenings (Erickson to check with Superintendent's office)
      - Erickson will review the calendar in complete and send out for approval to the committee
