Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Dawn Wagner to approve May minutes and was seconded by Leslie Sales. It was unanimously approved.

Budget: Our district SAC balance is \$6,222.58. It went up this month due to unused A Money funds . We have \$3,514.93 in Walter Johnson/ Curriculum support account. Our fundraising account has a balance of \$1.807.24.

Vote- School Improvement Plan: After having the district and faculty review our SIP, Jennifer Norris presented our SIP Plan for approval to SAC.
