- 2024-2025 Calendar
- Discussion
- August $5^{\text {th } 1 / 2}$ day
- August $6^{\text {th }}$ PL Day - moved to earlier in the week, August $5^{\text {th }}$ or 6 th
- Flip District PL Day to Monday, August $5^{\text {th }}$ and then put the $1 / 2$ and $1 / 2$ day on the 6 th.
- $6^{\text {th }}$ is orientation day.
- Imbed new curriculum for teachers during PL
- PL day is using the classrooms at VBHS
- August $7^{\text {th }}$ teacher planning, HS \& MS orientation
- August $8^{\text {th }}$ teacher planning, Elementary orientation
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- Start time, change to Wednesday, August $14^{\text {th }}$ instead of Monday, August 12
- Option days on Friday and Monday before the PL day and orientation
- Crisafulli - advised that would take away 2 days of instruction for students.
- G. Johnson - would like to get clarification for this to see if delaying start date would be an issue.
- Erickson - Will ask the leadership if its possible to have a delay start.
- G. Johnson - just curious and thinking maybe we can do that on the next calendar 25-26
- Murray - Conferences - October \& February, conference night on a Tuesday, is difficult for teachers to have a long night.
- Flip elementary with MS \& HS days
- Erickson - advised it was voted on last year.
- Murray - Parents were confused that it was on Tuesday, as it has always been, and some parents took Thursday night off since that Friday is off for the students.
- Beckham - advised we need to look at all and not what has always been done
- Crisafulli - advised to switch the elementary and MS/HS each year so it is fair to all teachers
- Pinkney - HS teachers aren't staying late, and how the nights are arranged. Don't see a problem with elementary teachers switching with
- Crisafulli - in contract now, only 3 hours at night
- Erickson - asked what do you want to see.
- Everyone - HS, MS then Elementary, October \& February for 2024-2025
- G. Johnson - Asked about not seeing hurricane days on the calendar.
- Erickson advised that $1 / 2$ days will be changed to full days.
- Pinkney liked the hurricane $1 / 2$ days plan
- Murray - why is Spring Break is so early, Would seem semester ending week before spring break. Get report cards before break
- Makes for a very long April and May
- Semester to end week of the $19^{\text {th }}$ of March
- Crisafulli - If off week the quarter ends, when would the grades go in
- Erickson - can check about why it was scheduled for so early and find out
- Dorian - advised it has been out for parent review and parents plan way ahead
- Erickson - asked if only other changes, no others were brought forth.
- New Business
- 24-25 "Tentative Calendar" discussion/vote
- No votes tonight, due to questions. Erickson will get those answers and voting needs to be focused on during the next meeting.
- 25-26 calendar discussion
- G. Johnson - August begins early, maybe pushing to mid-week
- Erickson - Veterans Day is not a holiday, Tuesday in the middle of the week
- Spring break that is early and a day off in April that isn't tied to any holiday. Giving up with 3-day weekend, but combine that with spring break, get out first day in June.
- Religious Holidays - Possibly take October 3rd off for Yom Compour in observance.
- Veterans Day - Change November $7^{\text {th }}$ to November $10^{\text {th }}$ or $11^{\text {th }}$ the students, Erickson- revisit veterans council asking about the students being off mid-week or have students in school
- Conferences - Move back to elementary going Thursday, instead of Tuesday in October \& February
- Start Times - If changes, who ever is last out then the first in
- Good Friday - if spring break were moved to a week later, that would cover the Good Friday off for Christians
