Call to Order:

A meeting of the Sebastian Elementary School Advisory Council was held in Media Center on October 16, 2023, Mrs. Sherrill-Long called the meeting to order at 5:10 P.M. Monica Sherrill-Long recorded minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:
