**Indian River County, FL** –The Florida Department of Health in Indian River County (DOH-Indian River) is offering immunizations for grades K-12 at our Back-to-School Immunization Clinic on August 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> from 8:00AM to 4:30PM. No appointment necessary. Please bring your child’s immunization record and parent ID with you. The Back-to-School Immunization clinic will be held at Florida Department of Health in Indian River County located at 1900 27<sup>th</sup> Street, Vero Beach, FL 32960.

“New and transferring students, kindergarten students and those entering seventh grade are required to have immunizations before the first day of school”, said Miranda Hawker, Florida Department of Health in Indian River County Administrator. The first day of school in Indian River County is August 12<sup>th</sup>.
