

Focus Group Feedback Summary

The Student Success Focus Group was held on Wednesday, January 29, 2020 with 8 participants providing feedback.

The table below provides an overview of the different areas in which feedback was obtained and the major themes that were identified through analysis of the feedback provided. Additionally, the percentage of participants providing feedback related to the identified theme is indicated in the parentheses following each theme. Further information also is provided with regard to participant ratings related to the quality of strategies and measures of success currently associated with Goal 1: Student Success in the existing Strategic Plan. The following rating scale was used: 1 = Poor; 2 = Fair; 3 = Average; 4 = Good; 5 = Excellent Strategies – Average of Ratings = 2.0 (example rationale provided: strategies are "way too global.") Measures of Success – Average of Ratings = 2.1 (example rationale provided: "strategies and measures are not aligned.")
