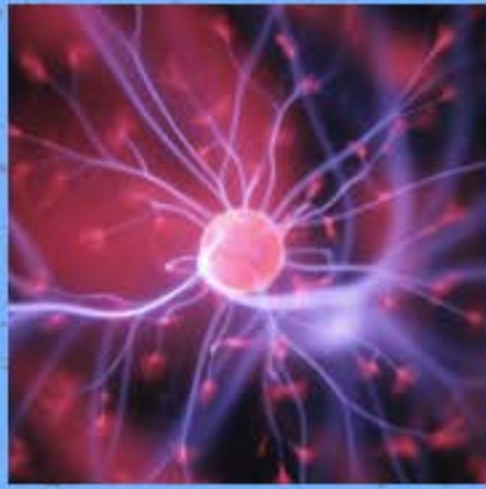

Camp Steam is a summer learning opportunity to enhance students' athletic, technology, and problem-solving skills. Students can select from one of two pathways:

1. Mathletes with Crossover Mission
- Or
2. Mathletes with TechVentures: Summer Glow-up Design Challenge

In **Mathletes**, which is a component of pathway 1 and 2, students will participate in multiple hands-on activities that foster a growth mindset and problem-solving skills. These skills will then be transferred to real-world math problems, such as solving a forensic science mystery using clues and multiple representations of data. Students will also build community and collaboration amongst their peers. Application of these competencies can be leveraged across other content areas.

Students who select **Crossover Mission** as their pathway, will engage in various athletic games and experiences that can shape the students' vision about what is possible in their own education and careers. They will engage in fun, purpose-driven experiences, from present-oriented thinking to future-driven exposure, skill development, and dream building.

Students who select the **TechVentures** pathway: Summer Glow Up Design Challenge, will have the opportunity to use technology tools such as Canvas, Microsoft Office 365, Adobe Spark, and Flipgrid. Using these and other technology tools, students will create a digital portfolio highlighting their student achievements and improve their digital footprint while developing alternative energy community proposals for Indian River County. They will explore the process of reverse engineering solar powered cars to determine how to redesign solar energy panels to be more aesthetically appealing and cost effective to broaden their positive impact on our community.
