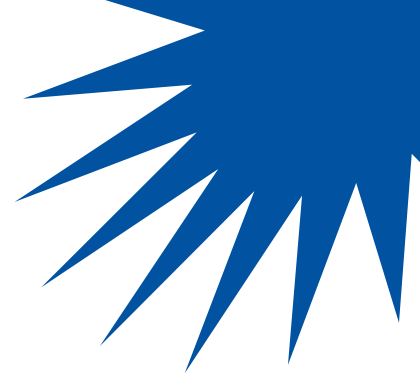

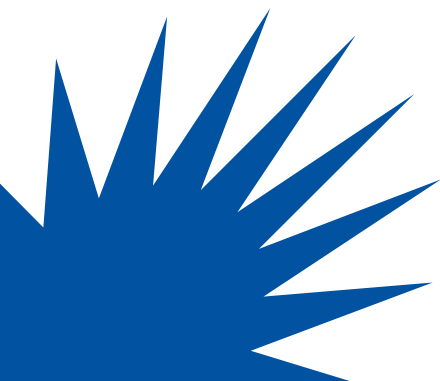

Book Club:

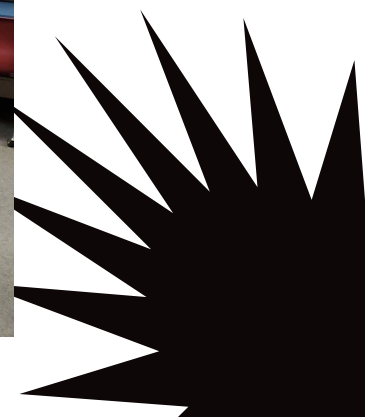
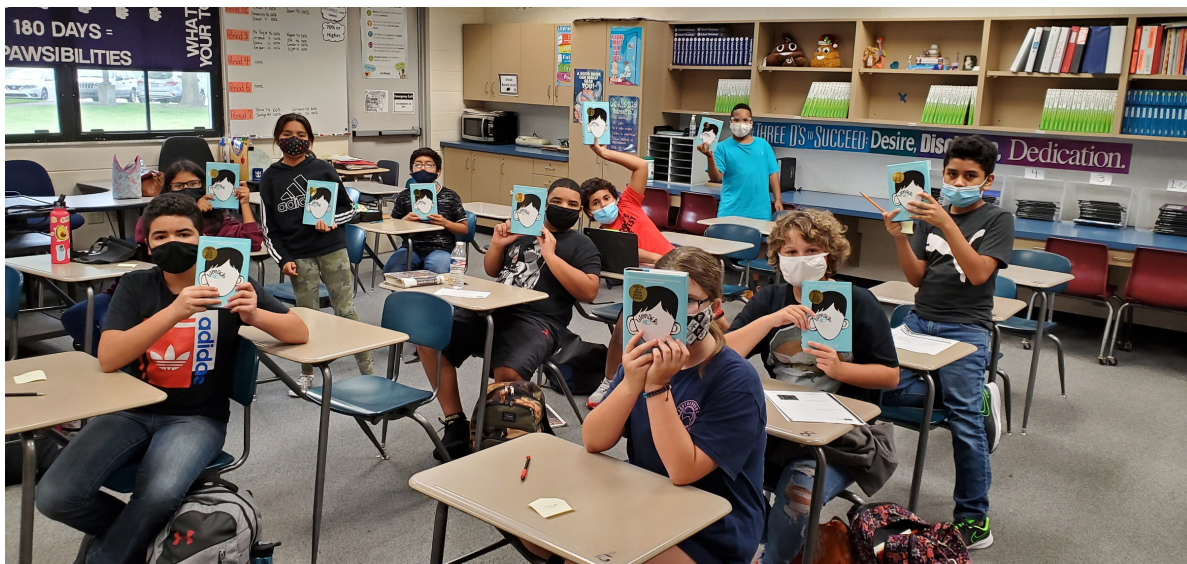
Students explore many genres of books and discuss different aspects of each one.
