

Dual Enrollment Important Information for Indian River County

The Indian River State College Dual Enrollment program allows eligible public, charter, private and home education students to simultaneously earn high school credit (toward their high school diploma) and credit toward an Associate Degree or career training certificate for an eligible course.

Through IRSC Dual Enrollment, eligible students get a jump on college, saving both time and money. Dual Enrollment students are exempt from application fees, tuition and laboratory fees, and public, charter and home school students receive required textbooks at no charge.

Please see important timeline information:

It is highly recommended and encouraged that Current Dual Enrollment students schedule an appointment with their IRSC Academic Advisor before spring registration begins. This is the student's responsibility to make the appointment. Students should check their MyPioneerPortal to confirm who their IRSC Academic Advisor is and make the appointment with that person. Appointments are available during normal business hours between September 1 – October 10. Appointments can be made by visiting: <https://irsc.edu/admissions/qless.html>

At these meetings, students will discuss their overall academic goals and complete an academic plan (guided pathway) for their DE courses. These appointments are NOT available once registration begins so it is very important that these meetings are made during the allotted time. All students are required to meet with their high school counselors each semester regarding their Dual Enrollment intentions.

Spring registration begins: October 17, 2022

Registration can be completed by the student via their Pioneer Portal, in person or virtually during normal business hours. Please plan ahead and find a time to make this happen before the registration deadline. Please keep in mind that the college is closed November 21-25 for the Thanksgiving Break.

Spring registration ends: **December 9, 2022**. Student schedules will be locked that night and no other changes will be made to spring schedules.

If you are new to Dual Enrollment, your application must be completed by December 5 so there is time to process it and approve you for DE and allow you time to actually register for spring classes by the December 9 deadline.
