The School District of Indian River County in collaboration with the Florida Department of Health (DOH) will be holding an Immunization Clinic at Pelican Island Elementary for students who are in need of immunizations. If this is the first time your child will be entering the School District, we want to remind parents of the school entry requirements: Per Florida Statue, 1003.22, "prior to admittance to or attendance in a public or private school, grades kindergarten through 12, or any other initial entrance into a Florida public or private school, each child to bring or have on file with the school a certification of immunization..." New and transferring students, kindergarten students, and those entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade are required to have immunizations prior to school entry.

- Current Insurance Card if applicable
