Violation #10. Food container

A stainless steel scoop was found with handle in contact with flour inside of a storage container. Scoops are best to be stored outside of containers, but are allowable if handle is upright and not in contact with contents of container. This was corrected onsite during the time of inspection.

CODE REFERENCE: Storage Containers. 64E-11.004(13)(14). Food storage containers shall be clean, covered, and marked with their contents.

Refrigerated, ready-to-eat, potentially hazardous food prepared in the facility, must be marked with date of preparation, if held greater than 24 hours.

Food must be stored six inches above the floor.
